Get inspired with these tips to set up your own woodland treasure hunt:

## Treasure!

Add to the excitement by hiding small rewards along the quiz trail, as well as a big prize at the end of it :O)



## Make it a challenge

It's no fun if it's too easy, so place some of the questions high up, low down, partially hidden...

## Use it again

Laminate the questions sheets before you set up your trail – they'll be shower-proof so will last longer, and can be used again :O)



## Give some clues

Write clues to help the treasure hunters find each question – print the tag templates to write them on.

## Leave signs

Use twigs and stones to create natural signposts. Make simple arrows that are easy to follow, or devise a code of signs for the treasure hunters to crack :O)



Please remember to leave the wood as you found it and take any pictures or clues you've used home with you :O)
