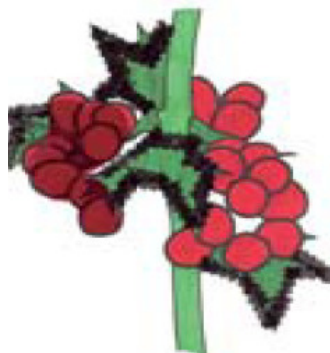
bits 'n' bobs
