

# Badger pumpkin stencil

Cut out the **black** areas then stick this stencil to the front of a pumpkin (after you've scooped the flesh and seeds out).

Using a permanent marker pen draw around the shapes onto to pumpkin. When you've finished, remove the paper and, using a knife – careful(!), cut out the shapes that you've just drawn onto the pumpkin. You might need a bit of help with this as pumpkins can get very slippery :O)
