What you need

Per person:
Two handfuls of blackberries
2-3 tbsp of fruit juice



How to make

Go on a blackberry picking adventure!

Rummage through the hedgerows between August and October to find some lovely, juicy ones (leaving some for the birds too :O) then stick them in the freezer when you get home.

Mix two handfuls of the frozen berries with the fruit juice and blitz in a blender until it's all nice and smooth.

That's it! A yummy, chilled, easy peasy, bramble freezy.

Top tip:

Keep some blackberries stashed in the freezer, ready to make this on a miserable wintry day for a burst of summer sunshine :O)
